



Windows 7* USB 3.0 Creator Utility

Windows 7 installation media does not include native driver support for USB 3.0, so during installation, when you get to the screen to select your preferred language, a keyboard or mouse connected to a USB 3.0 port does not respond.

The Windows 7 USB 3.0 Creator Utility helps to update a Windows 7 installation image to include USB 3.0 drivers.

NOTE: This application **ONLY** works on **Windows 8.1 and later**.

Assumptions

- You have a valid copy of Windows 7 on ISO or DVD.
- You have Administrator access to another working computer (the Admin system) with Windows 7 or later to follow these steps.
- You have download and unzipped the [Windows 7 USB 3.0 Creator Utility](#).

Getting Ready

Create a USB flash drive installer

- Use your Windows 7 DVD or ISO image to create a bootable USB flash drive. Instructions on how to do are found on [Microsoft's website](#).

Run the Utility

1. Download and unzip the Windows 7 USB 3.0 Creator utility to a temporary folder on the Admin system.
2. Connect the USB device containing the Windows 7 image to the Admin system.
3. Right-click the file **Installer_Creator.exe** and select **Run as administrator**.
4. Browse to the root of the USB drive.
5. Click **Create Image** to begin the creation process.
6. Wait for the process to finish. It can take up to 15 minutes.
